Further to receiving the above Temporary Event Notice (TEN) application, which is for an event to be held on the 27<sup>th</sup> to the 28<sup>th</sup> of October 2017, may I make the following observations.

Whilst considering the details of the application the Environmental Health Section would like to **object** to the application due to the fact that we believe that the Public Nuisance and Public Safety objective will not be met due to the following reasons

- The applicant is seeking to provide the Supply of Alcohol, Regulated Entertainment and Late Night Refreshment from 18:00 until 04:00.
- Previous events held at the above premises over similar hours have resulted in a number of noise related complaints being received from members of the public.
- Public Safety concerns from events held at this location previously.
- Insufficient information provided by the applicant to demonstrate how the event will not undermine both Public Safety and Public Nuisance objectives of the Licensing Act.

I would invite the applicant to submit an Event Management Plan (EMP) for the attention of the Environmental Health Section. The EMP should outline what appropriate control measures the applicant intends putting in place to ensure that the event does not undermine the Public Nuisance and Public Safety objectives of the Licensing Act.
