The Assistant Solicitor briefed all present on the procedure for the meeting and advised the Sub- Committee that an application had been received for the grant of a personal licence for Miss Sarah Pearce of Flat 2, 2-4 Norton Road, Penygroes, Llanelli, SA14 7RS.

The Committee were asked to consider an application from Miss Sarah Pearce for a personal licence, under Section 117 of the Licensing Act 2003.

The police had objected to the Application under section 120(5) of the Licensing Act 2003, as the applicant had been convicted of a "relevant offence" listed in Schedule 4 of the Act, and were of the view that granting the licence would undermine the Crime Prevention Objective in the 2003 Act.

The Sub-Committee received observations from the Police representative regarding the convictions and both the applicant, and the Sub-Committee, were provided with an opportunity of questioning the evidence provided by the Police representative.

The applicant, who was supported by her mother thereupon addressed the SubCommittee in support of her application, and the Sub-Committee and the Police representative were afforded the opportunity of questioning the evidence provided.

The applicant also submitted two written representations in support of her application.

The Sub-Committee thereupon
UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED to retire into private session in order to receive legal advice pursuant to Paragraph 16 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972.

Following the adjournment, the Sub-Committee reconvened to advise of its decision. Having considered all the evidence before it, the Sub-Committee

UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED that Miss Pearce's application for a personal license under the Licensing Act 2003 be refused.

## Reason

The Committee having regard to the evidence and representation presented, was not satisfied that Miss Pearce was a fit and proper person to hold a licence and that granting the licence was likely to give rise to crime and disorder and would undermine the Crime Prevention Objective of the Licensing Act 2003.

## 4. APPLICATION FOR THE GRANT OF A HACKNEY CARRIAGE/PRIVATE HIRE DUAL DRIVERS LICENCE - MRS ERIKA PROBERT-GARTHWAITE

The Committee interviewed Mrs Erika Probert-Garthwaite with regard to her application.

The Senior Licensing Officer recommended that Mrs Probert Garthwaite's application be refused.

The Committee thereupon:

## 5. PRIVATE HIRE VEHICLE LICENCE

(NOTE: Councillor E. Thomas, having earlier declared an interest in this item, left the Council Chamber during its determination.)

The Committee considered an application from Mr Michael John Wilkinson of Llandeilo Taxi Service, Kings Lodge, Llandeilo to be granted an exemption from conditions 5a and 5b of the Council's Licence Conditions for Private Hire Vehicles for his Private Hire Vehicle PH399, a Ford Mondeo Vignale registration number MX19 VBE.

As he intends to operate this vehicle for air and sea port travel and executive hire only, Mr Wilkinson had requested that he be granted an exemption from conditions $5 a$ and 5b of the Council's Licence Conditions, namely that he be not required to display door stickers and a licence plate on the rear bumper of his vehicle.

Should the Licensing Committee agree to grant Mr Wilkinson an exemption then the following conditions would be attached to the Licence:-

- That the licensed Ford Mondeo Vignale PH399 registration number MX19 VBE be exempt from licence conditions $5 a$ and $5 b$ whilst being used for air and sea port travel and executive hire purposes, as outlined in the application by Mr Wilkinson;
- That, should the vehicle be used for Private Hire other than air and sea port travel and executive hire, then the applicant shall immediately notify the Licensing Authority and the exemption shall cease in relation to such hiring;
- That the vehicle displays an identification disc on the front and rear windscreens, as specified by the Licensing Authority.

RESOLVED that the application submitted by Mr Michael John Wilkinson for an exemption from Conditions 5a and 5b of the Council's Licence Conditions for Private Hire Vehicles for his Ford Mondeo Vignale PH399, registration number MX19 VBE be granted.
