SAFEGUARDING TRAINING FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGE/PRIVATE HIRE DUAL DRIVERS

Since July 2017, the Licensing Section have provided Safeguarding training sessions for our Licensed Taxi Drivers in Carmarthenshire. These training sessions were a joint initiative between this Authority and Dyfed Powys Police.

The training sessions were tailored specifically for taxi drivers so they could learn about safeguarding including Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE) and how they, as taxi drivers can play an important role. This training was to help the taxi drivers recognise potential issues, and give them the confidence and contact details in order to refer it.

To date, we have run a total of 19 Training sessions throughout the County with 474 licensed taxi drivers having attended the training. Facilitating these training sessions required several Officers from the Authority and Police to attend on each occasion.

There are currently 144 Licensed Taxi Drivers in Carmarthenshire who have not attended the safeguarding training sessions and this figure will increase as new applications are received. It is our intention that all taxi drivers licensed by Carmarthenshire County Council will have received Safeguarding Training.

Therefore, a joint initiative was agreed where we would produce a Safeguarding Training Video that could be used for all Taxi Drivers and Passenger assistants in the Dyfed Powys Police Force Area, namely Carmarthenshire County Council, Ceredigion County Council, Pembrokeshire County Council and Powys County Council.

The cost of this Training Video was covered by funds raised under POCA (Proceeds of Crime Act) by Carmarthenshire County Council.

The Safeguarding video will be played at the meeting to inform the decision making process.

2. AMENDMENT TO DUTY OF CARE TO HOUSEHOLDERS

The Executive Board Member considered a report which provided an overview of the reason for endorsing the enablement of Environmental Officers to issue a fix penalty for the offence of Household waste duty of care instead of prosecuting offenders through the court.

The offences of duty of care relate to householders who do not dispose of their waste correctly and does not apply where waste is collected by Carmarthenshire County Council.

It was noted that the ability to issue a fixed penalty ticket is an amendment under Section 34(2A) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990. The Fixed Penalty Notice fines proposed for a breach of householder duty of care was £300 and an early payment of £150 offered if paid within 10 days. The amounts stated were fixed following recommendations from the Welsh Government to have a consistent approach across Wales.

RESOLVED that the amendment to the duty of care to householders fixed penalty notice be approved.
