CCC Event Support Fund Applications February 2019

1. BRIEF SUMMARY OF PURPOSE OF REPORT

As part of a series of actions to grow the contribution of events and festivals in Carmarthenshire, £20,000.00 has been approved to provide an event support fund scheme aimed at providing financial assistance to events in the county that can demonstrate that they can make a contribution to the Tourism, Community and Economic strategic aims. As of 10th January 2019, £2,000 has already been committed from the 19/20 fund whilst the following applications have been received and assessed against the criteria with recommendations listed below;

i. Great Welsh Marathon & Half Marathon 2019: Recommended support £2,500.00

ii. Llandovery Sheep Festival 2019: Recommended support £2,000.00

iii. Cross Hands Family Fun day 2019: Recommended support £0

iv. Llandeilo Literature Festival 2019: Recommended support £1,360.00

v. Llanelli Ramblers Walking Festival 2019: Recommended support £0

vi. Excel Community Festival 2019: Recommended support £0

vii. Superprix 2019: Further discussions to be held

Total amount recommended £5,860.00

2. OTHER OPTIONS AVAILABLE AND THEIR PROS AND CONS

With the scheme in past years oversubscribed in terms of requests v funds total, there is the option to keep some funds in reserve for the possibility of receiving higher scoring applications between now and the end of the financial year in March 2020

Efficiencies and improvements can be made if the event organisers make greater use of the various templates and case studies (from marketing to h&s) supplied from the County Council and the respective offer letters will detail the need to evidence pre and post event usage of some of these. Each event organiser will receive specific criteria evidence and items to be supported within their respective offer letters allowing for greater clarity on the impact of the council support
