The Licensing Authority believes that the following sections of the Statutory Guidance are relevant to this licence application: - Section 1 Introduction, Section 2 relating to The Licensing Objectives, Section 5 relating to Premises licences, Section 8 relating to Applications for Premises Licences and Section 10 relating to Licence Conditions.

e) Relevant Sections of the Local Licensing Policy.



The Licensing Authority believes that the following sections of Carmarthenshire's Licensing Policy are relevant to this licence application:- Section 3 Fundamental principles, Section 4 Conditions of Licence, Sections 5 – 9 relating to The Licensing Objectives and Section 11 relating to Licensing Hours.

f) Proposed Operating Schedule.

Having considered the other statements contained in the operating schedule put forward by the applicants, the Licensing Authority believes that, if the application were granted, the wording set out in the operating schedule, is sufficiently precise to enable it to form clear enforceable licence conditions in accordance with section 18(2)(a) of the Licensing Act.

However the Dyfed Powys Police have submitted representations requesting that additional conditions be attached to the licence. The applicant has reached agreement with the Police Licensing Officer, that the amended conditions numbered 1-10,12 and 13 as set out in an e-mail dated 7th of March 2016 be attached to any licence granted.

In the circumstances it would therefore be appropriate to replace all the original statements within the application that refer to CCTV and an age recognition scheme with the agreed conditions.

As stated in paragraph C overleaf, the planning department have indicated that the current planning consent does not cover the proposed trading hours sought in the application. I would ask the applicant to confirm what steps have been taken to address this matter.

Public Health services have put forward 5 licence conditions which they believe are appropriate to the application, as part of their letter of representation, dated the 9th of March 2016.

I note that a number of representations, opposing the grant of the licence have been received from local residents and their representative. The subcommittee will have to be satisfied that granting the application will not undermine the licensing objectives.

Subject to the above, the department does not object in principle to the granting of the application. These representations have been prepared on the 9th of March 2016 with the benefit of viewing the original application and representations from the Police, Public Health Services and other persons.

I would be grateful if the applicant could contact me to discuss the above representations at the earliest opportunity and certainly prior to the application being referred to a Licensing Sub Committee hearing for determination.

With reference to the above application the Carmarthenshire Division of the Dyfed Powys Police will make the following representations.

- 1. The whole of the licensed area with entry and exit areas must be covered by CCTV cameras, and there must not be any hidden or obscured areas.

- 3. All footage must be of good quality and of a minimum performance capability sufficient to identify individuals.
- 4. It must be in colour.
- 5. It must record at a minimum of 12 images per second.

- 7. All footage during the hours of Licensable activities to be retained for a period of 28 days.

Further to submitting my representations on the 2nd of March 2016 with regards to the above application, I would like to amend the suggested conditions. Subsequent to submitting my original representation I have been made aware that planning approval Ref No E/32738 was granted for this premise on the 4th of February 2016. The approval was for a "New Development Of a Retail Unit with 4 No Residential Apartments Above With Associated Parking, With Refurbishments Of 178 Cwmamman Road To Be Ground Floor Retail Unit And First Floor Residential Apartment".

In light of the above information in particular the information specifying that there will be residential properties above the proposed Licensed Premises I would like to amend my original conditions to ensure that they are reasonable, precise and enforceable.

With the above in mind, I would like to recommend that the previously proposed conditions are amended to the suggested conditions below to ensure that the "Prevention of Public Nuisance" of the Licensing objectives is being promoted.

1. No deliveries or collections shall take place between the hours of 23:00hours and 07:00 hours unless prior written approval has been received from the Environmental Health and Licensing Section



2. The internal noise levels at any residential property located above the Licensed Premise shall not exceed

Bedrooms $(23.00hrs - 07.00hrs) - 30dBL_{Aeq}(8hr)$ and 45 dBL_{Amax}

Living Rooms (07.00hrs – 23.00hrs) – 35 dBL_{Aeq} (16hr)

- 3. For all other residential properties the rating level of the noise emitted from the proposed development shall not exceed the existing background noise level. This shall include noise from all plant items, deliveries or collections associated with the premises. The noise levels shall be determined at the nearest noise sensitive premises or at another location that is deemed suitable by the authority.
 Measurements and assessments shall be made in accordance with BS 4142: 2014 Methods for rating and assessing industrial and commercial sound.
- 4. At the written request of the Environmental Health and Licensing Section, the operator within a period of 1 month shall undertake and submit to the authority a noise assessment conforming to BS 4142: 2014 Methods for rating and assessing industrial and commercial sound to determine whether noise arising from development exceeds the level specified in condition 3 above. The assessment shall be undertaken under the supervision of the Local Authority. In the event that Condition 3 is exceeded then the submitted survey shall also include mitigation measures to ensure compliance with the noise level specified in condition 3. The development shall then be undertaken in accordance with the approved details.
- 5. Any form of artificial lighting to be used at the premises shall be installed in accordance with good practice issued by the Institute of Lighting Engineers. The lighting shall be appropriate to ensure nearby properties are not subjected to unreasonable level of obtrusive light. In line with the relevant guidance, all lighting used should be as directional as possible and use the minimum number of lights required to achieve its purpose.

In order to demonstrate that the premises can comply with condition number 2 and 3 then it would be advisable for the applicant to undertake a Noise Impact Assessment(NIA). This NIA may assist the applicant to demonstrate to the Licensing Committee members that they are able to comply with the conditions. Thereby ensuring that the application will not undermine the Public Nuisance objective.

Should a NIA be undertaken then the Environmental Health and Licensing Section would expect the following

- (a) The independent acoustic consultant to be suitably qualified and experienced to undertake the assessment.
- (b) A copy of the acoustic consultant's report to be submitted to the Licensing Section and Public Health Section of Carmarthenshire County Council prior to the Licensing Committee.
- (c) Should the acoustic consultant advise in his/her report to undertake any mitigation works, then these works should be completed and written confirmation must be

received from the consultant confirming that the works has been completed to his/her satisfaction.

Should you agree with the above and wish to accept the conditions, you are required to confirm in writing that you do so. A copy of your acceptance should be forwarded to the Licensing Section and myself.





I would like to make the following observations with regards the above application:

The Aman valley now has more than ample off licence shops to serve the population. Only in the last month, a new premises has opened directly opposite the proposed site for One Stop, this means, that in less than a two mile radius there are already four off licences and nine licensed premises

The proposed development is in a primarily residential area and I have concerns that increased footfall especially late evening with people shopping for alcoholic products would impinge on residents' basic human right to a quality private life.

The proposed development is on an area of Cwmaman road which has serious issues with traffic and road safety. The nature of the business wil mean an increase in night time pedestrian traffic, with the possibility of many being already under the influenceof alcohol I have serious concerns over road and pedestrian safety in the immediate area.

The proposed one stop site is adjacent to a large park area which has been identified as an area where youths gather unsupervised and is renowned for anti-social behaviour, primarily alcohol abuse - having two retail premises selling alcohol in close proximity would increase the availability of cheap alcohol thus increasing the frequency of anti social behaviour.

In these days, with concerns about alcohol abuse, especially amongst the young, a large retail premises which, in my opinion will struggle to adequately monitor the sale of cut price alcohol to minors will only add to the problem and contribute to antisocial behaviour and alcohol abuse in the Cwmaman area.

I also have grave concerns about the proposed times that alcohol can be sold, there is no justification for any premises to sell alcohol from 0600 through until 2300 and no reason whatsoever that alcohol should be sold on Sundays outside the times that other licensed premises trade.

My name is Khadim Hussain and I am local business owner in Glanamman. I am writing to you to object to the granting of a premises licence, for proposed One Stop store on Cwmamman Road, Garnant.

My reasons for objections are I am concerned about the impact it will have on the local community. I have been here now for over 16 years and in that time I have gotten to know a lot of the residents really well. Those living in the vicinity of the proposed sight, Have expressed concerns to me about the hazards that will arise should this license be granted. They include

- Anti Social behaviour, including swearing, fighting, broken bottles as well as excessive noise, and damage to property.
- Risk to children. There a lot of young families in that area, especially in the Arcade Terrace Estate behind the proposed site. They have had a peaceful, quiet and safe area to live in up until now. But with extra traffic, footfall and sale of alcohol from early morning until late at night, They will have to put up with a lot worse now. including some of the pitfalls I have outlined above
- There is already a licensed premises opposite the site, and This has led to a greater police presence in the area, and another licensed property will only make this worse. I know local officers are concerned with the concentration of licensed premises in the area and they have reported an increase in calls regarding drunken behaviour.
- Residents may have their homes damaged given closeness to the store, So if a drunk person can go buy more alcohol until 11pm 7 days a week (as proposed) then they may knock down walls, scratch/vandalise cars as well as break windows.
- Drunken drivers. The proposed site has a car park, and with the exit being out onto main (Cwmamman) Road, there is a potential for serious accidents. Ad runk dirver could just go down, buy more booze, get in the car and drive out knocking someone down or worse. There is no way for those working inside the store to know if those they are selling alcohol to are driving or not.

I have my own concerns, regarding this outlet. To have so many licensed premises in a built up area is just asking for trouble. People will have hassle on their doorstep and it will be difficult for the licensee to enforce stringent licensing conditions given the nature of the area and plan of the site.

I live next door to the proposed sight, and I do not want to have people buying alcohol form early morning until late at night. This would cause a nuisance to me and my neighbours in terms of noise, and anti social behaviour. There is a lot of broken bottles and rubbish left on the main road already, and this will only get worse when the shop opens. I do not want loud noises, people arguing or lots of kids hanging around outside my home. The same goes for my neighbours. If alcohol is available from One Stop it will encourage more people to hang around causing a nuisance and also encourage kids to hang around hoping someone will buy them alcohol from there. There are many elderly residents here and they are scared by the large crowds and bright light/noise. This is especially hard for those who have trouble moving around as they cannot respond quick enough to problems.

Ever since The Ammanford Food and Wine store has opened up opposite me and the proposed One Stop Site, I have noticed an increase in the amount of people buying booze from there. This has led to fights, arguments and bad behaviour well into the night. This problem will only increase if another licensed premises opens up.

I worry for the safety of children who live locally, both on the main road and in the Arcade Terrace estate behind the One Stop site. They will have to see and hear drunks passing their houses, rubbish dropped and who knows what else.

Given the amount of licensed premises already in the area, I think another would just cause more problems.
