EXECUTIVE SUMMARY STANDARDS COMMITTEE 13TH JANUARY 2017

APPLICATION FOR DISPENSATION BY COUNCILLOR SHAHID HUSSAIN

An application for dispensation to speak, vote and make written representations has been received from Councillor Shahid Hussain of Cwmamman Town Council in relation to the re-location of the village post office in Cwmamman to premises in which Councillor Hussain has a business interest.

Councillor Hussain has a personal interest in this matter by virtue of the following paragraphs of the Code of Conduct;

- 1. 10(2)(a)(i) as the matter relates to or is likely to affect a business carried on by him.
- 2. 10(2)(a)(ix)(bb) as the matter relates to or is likely to affect a company in which he holds a position of general control or management
- 3. 10(2)(b)(i) as the matter might reasonably be regarded as affecting his wellbeing

This interest is also a prejudicial interest as a member of the public, with full knowledge of the facts, would reasonably regard that interest as so significant as to prejudice the Councillor's judgement of the public interest.

The application is submitted on 1 grounds specified in the Standards Committees (Grant of Dispensation)(Wales) Regulations 2001 namely;

(f) participation justified due to the member's particular role or expertise

Cllr Hussain has previously been granted dispensation to speak only in respect of this interest on the 11th September 2015. This dispensation expired on the 4th December 2015.

If the committee is minded to grant the application, it has an absolute discretion as to duration, it may grant it until the end of the Councillor's term of office, or some other date, such as the date of a future meeting of this committee.
