I previously submitted a similar application in May 2015 which was granted by the Committee. This enabled me to appoint Councillor Evans to the Executive Board at that time and she remained in office until the local authority elections on the 4th May 2017. I have a personal interest in the appointment of Cllr Evans given that she is my sister in law and her appointment to the Executive Board would be likely to affect her well-being and financial position as the post carries a senior salary greater than that received by non-executive board members.
