<p>2. Finance ERW is heavily dependent on grant funding from Welsh Government. Delays in Welsh Government confirming funding for 2017-18 presents difficulties in meaningful business planning. There has also been delays in paying grant funding from the previous year which has led to financial pressure on the Lead Banker. Currently the ERW Business Plan is not aligned to the financial model, this presents concerns over the achievability of the plan within existing resources.</p>
