To consider an application from Scarlets Regional Ltd for a premises licence in respect of the above premises.

To allow:-

- Supply of Alcohol/Regulated Entertainment/Boxing or Wrestling/Opening Hours Monday to Sunday 07:00 – 02:00;
- Late Night Refreshment Monday to Sunday 23:00 02:00

Seasonal Variations and Non-Standard Timings:

A further additional hour into the morning following every Christmas Eve(December 24<sup>th</sup>), Boxing Day (December 26<sup>th</sup>), New Years Day (January 1<sup>st</sup>), St Davids Day (March 1<sup>st</sup>) and St Patricks Day (March 17<sup>th</sup>). A further two hours into the morning for Friday and Saturday NIghts in December for Christmas Parties. On New Years Eve from the end of permitted hours pn December 31<sup>st</sup> to the start of Permitted hours on the following day, January 1<sup>st</sup>.

Major international sporting events - The option to open 30 minutes before to 30 minutes after, inclusive, for any major international sporting event that is televised and held in a country or countries operating on a different time zone to that of the UK co joining should they overlap. Major sporting events included in the above clause are as follows, Rygby World Cup, Football World Cup, European Rugby and Football competitions, Olympic Games, European and Commenwealth Games, Cricket International and World Cup Games, major boxing matches and American Football final

The use of the pitch for regulated entertainment and late night refreshment is limited to 6 occasions per calendar year.
