To consider a request from Mrs Carys Ifan on behalf of Canolfan S4C Yr Egin for a recommendation regarding the admission of children to view an unclassified short film.

The applicant wishes to screen “Helfa’r Heli” at the centre. The screening will be authorised under a temporary event notice submitted by the applicant under Section 100 of the Licensing Act 2003.

In order to satisfy the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003, the film shown must have a recommendation concerning the admission of children issued by either the film classification body (BBFC) or relevant licensing authority, which in this case is ourselves.

This film has previously been considered by committee and given an age classification of 12A in relation to a screening at a different premises.

The committee is asked to refer to the guidelines in relation to age ratings produced by the British Board of Film Classification (BBFC).
