CARMARTHEN SHOPMOBILITY

The County Council has supported the Carmarthen Shopmobility scheme since 2011. The current funding arrangement is due to expire this year.

The Carmarthen scheme provides a valuable service for the mobility impaired and has been successful with circa 1,289 uses per annum.

The group generates income from charges and fund raising. The scheme is however mainly reliant on the County Council's financial support. The Group has requested further financial support from the Council for the forthcoming 12 months to the sum of £14,650.

Shopmobility is one of many initiatives being encouraged by the Authority to support the town. It fits with the Authority's Parking Strategy priorities

The Council has set aside funding to fund a further twelve months support.
