<b>Budget Monitoring 2019/20</b>	This item enables members to undertake their monitoring role of the Environment Department, Public Protection Services and Community Safety Team's revenue and capital budgets. <b>Environmental Protection Annual Report 2018/19 &amp; Service Delivery Plan for 2019-20</b>	A combined report which provides information on the work undertaken by the Environmental Protection department during 2018/19 and sets out the department plans for 2019/20.	The Committee is being requested to consider and comment on the work undertaken by the department over the last year and its plans for next year.
