Dispensation Application by Cllr Wendy Heron

Henllanfallteg Community Councillor Wendy Heron has submitted a dispensation request to speak and vote in relation to council business regarding the provision of a sewerage solution for the community hall, pub and several homes in the village.

Councillor Heron would have a personal and prejudicial interest in such business as she is a trustee of the village hall.

Councillor Heron seeks dispensation, on the following grounds under the Standards Committees (Grant of Dispensations)(Wales) Regulations 2001

- 1. Regulation 2(2)(d) the nature of the member's interest is such that the member's participation in the business to which the interest relates would not damage public confidence in the conduct of the relevant authority's business.
- 2. Regulation 2(2) (e) the interest is common to the member and a significant proportion of the public.
- 3. Regulation 2(2)(f) the participation of the member in the business to which the interest relates is justified by the members particular role or expertise
- 4. Regulation 2(2)(h) the business which is to be considered relates to the finances or property of a voluntary organisation of whose management committee or board the member is a member otherwise than as a representative of the relevant authority and the member has no other interest in that business provided that any dispensation shall not extend to participation in any vote with respect to that business

The application also seeks to rely on the ground in Regulation 2(2)(c) relating to political balance, but this ground is not applicable in this case.

If the committee is minded to grant Councillor Heron 's request it will need to determine the duration of that dispensation
