Poplars Inn, Pondside, Johnstown, Carmarthen**

Further to the receipt of the above application, I would like to make the following representations on behalf of the Environmental Health Team of Carmarthenshire County Council. The Environmental Health Team of Carmarthenshire County Council have concerns over the variation application in its current format due to the following reasons:-

1. In the past four years, when the premise was under the management of previous premise licence holders, Environmental Health were in receipt of numerous complaints, which are detailed below:
 - Noise from loud music inside the premises
 - Noise from loud music outside in the beer garden of the premises.
 - Noise from cars leaving the car park of the premises
 - Noise from the emptying of bottles late at night
 - Noise from people singing and shouting in the beer garden of the premises
2. The property is a detached property; however it is located in between two residential properties which are in very close proximity. Therefore any noise arising from the premise does increase the potential for noise disturbance.
3. A new entrance is to be constructed allowing direct access from outside into the Lounge area of the premises. No information has been provided on the construction of the entrance or its management in order to control the noise emanating from within the premise. In my experience from dealing with other Licensed Premises within the County the use of Lobbied Entrances significantly reduces the amount of noise breakout from Licensing Premises.

4. The variation application is seeking to extend the premises opening hours until 2am on Monday to Sunday. Also it is seeking to allow the premises to play Live and Recorded Music up until 1am on Monday to Sunday. These changes to the Premises Licence if not adequately controlled will increase the potential for the premises to give rise to noise disturbance.
5. The applicant to my knowledge has not undertaken or submitted a risk assessment (as per paragraph 5.1 to 5.5 of Carmarthenshire County Council Licensing policy) to assess the potential impacts the variation application may have on the Licensing Objectives in particular the "Prevention of a Public Nuisance". Subsequently the application doesn't contain an operating schedule setting out in detail the control measures the applicant intends to put in place to deal with the risks identified in the assessment.

Therefore based on the above mentioned points we recommend that the application is amended to the following -:

Supply of Alcohol

Sunday to Thursday 07:00 – 00:00 / Friday- Saturday 07:00 - 01:30

Late night refreshment

Sunday to Thursday 23:00 – 23:30 / Friday- Saturday 23:00 - 01:00

Recorded music

Sunday to Thursday 07:00 – 00:00 / Friday- Saturday 07:00 - 01:00

Live music Monday

Sunday to Thursday 07:00 – 00:00 / Friday- Saturday 07:00 - 01:00

Opening Hours

Sunday to Thursday 07:00 – 00:30 / Friday- Saturday 07:00 - 02:00

In addition to the above we recommend that the following conditions are attached to the premises licence in order to ensure that the "Public Safety" and "Prevention of Public Nuisance" Licensing objectives are being promoted.

Prevention of Public Nuisance conditions

1. During periods of regulated entertainment all external windows and doors shall be kept closed, other than for access and egress to the premise.
2. No speakers shall be installed in any external areas of the premises

3. Bottles shall not be emptied into the bins outside the premises between 11:00pm and 7:00am.
4. Neighbour courtesy notices shall be displayed at the exits of the premises in order to inform patrons and staff to leave the premises quietly in respect of the local residents.
5. After 22:30 the consumption of alcohol shall not be permitted in any outside locations within the boundary of the premises.
6. The new external doorway leading into the Lounge area (*as highlighted in the variation application*) must be a lobbied entrance.

Public Safety conditions

7. After 9:00pm no glass drinking vessels shall be used in any external areas of the premises.

Should you agree with the above and wish to accept the conditions, you are required to confirm this in writing. A copy of your acceptance should be forwarded to the Licensing Section and myself.

Accepting the above will enable me to withdraw the representation and the above requirements will become conditions of your premises licence.

Environmental Protection Act 1990

I write to inform you that I have received two further noise complaints with regards to the above premises.

The first complaint was received on the 12th of January 2018 at 06:35am which was in relation to noise from glass bottles allegedly being emptied into the bin outside at 04:45am. The complainant informs us that this apparently is not an isolated incident and has experienced this noise previously. Therefore with regards to this complaint I would like to inform you of the complaint and request that the emptying of waste bottles is only carried out between the hours of 7am and 11pm. This will ensure that noise from this activity will be carried out at a reasonable time and thereby should not cause an unreasonable disturbance to neighbouring properties.

The second complaint was received on the 13th of January 2017 at 9:47pm where loud music and people noise from the premises allegedly disturbed a neighbouring property. The complainant has stated that the noise disturbed them from 9:47pm until 12:20 am on the 14th of January 2018. Therefore with regards to this complaint I would like inform you of the complaint received.

Additionally I have advised the complainant that our next course action would involve undertaking noise monitoring at their property in order to assess whether or not the noise being complained of is

a statutory noise nuisance. Once noise monitoring has been undertaken I shall provide you with an update with regards to this matter. If you require any further information or assistance please do not hesitate to contact me.

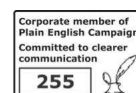

I write to inform you that I have received three separate noise complaints with regards to an event held at the above premises on the 26th of August 2018.

The complainants have submitted noise recordings to the Local Authority via the Noise App. On listening to the recordings submitted there is evidence of loud music being clearly audible at their respective properties.

In addition to this Environmental Health Section objected to the two Temporary Event Notices (TEN's) that you submitted for events to be held on the 30th of June 2018 and the 26th /27th of August 2018. Our objection was based on the fact that in our professional opinion we believed that the "Prevention of a Public Nuisance" objective will not be met during these events.

Based on the evidence provided by the three complainants on the 26th of August 2018 it seems that we were correct in making our objections. Also I do have concerns that noise from the event may have resulted in a Public Nuisance. Therefore should you decide to hold similar events in future then we would have to consider to undertake noise monitoring at nearby residents properties in order to assess the level of noise and to decide whether or not there is a Statutory Noise Nuisance.

I would like to take this opportunity to advise you that should we gather evidence that constitutes a Statutory Noise Nuisance, then we will not have any further options but to serve a Notice under the provisions of Section 80 of that Act. This notice will be served on you as the owner/the person responsible for the nuisance.

Further to our telephone conversation on the 11th of June 2019 with regards to the Gin Festival event at the Poplars Johnstown. From our discussion the event is planned for the 29/06/2019 and based on what you mentioned that you would be looking to apply for a TEN to cover the following:-

- Have Live Music outside up until 10pm and then the music would only be played inside.
- Extend the use of the external areas to allow customers consumption of alcohol up to a time of approximately 11:30pm to 12pm.

I have considered what you have mentioned above and suggest that should a TEN application be received for the above then Environmental Health would most likely object to the TEN for the following reasons.

- As it currently stands your Premises Licence already permits outdoor Live Music to be played up to 10pm. Therefore you do not require a TEN to enable you to do this.
- Live Music in the outdoor areas will end at 10pm, therefore I don't not see what would be the reason to extend the use of the external areas for the consumption of alcohol past the 10:30pm curfew that already exists on your Premises Licence. Given that after 10 pm entertainment will be held inside the premises, the customers in my opinion would be inside the premises listening to the entertainment being provided.
- You are aware that we already have ongoing investigation on noise complaint, where noise from customers in the beer garden is one of the issues being complained about. Given that the next course of action with this complaint has yet to be decided upon, I don't feel that agreeing to your potential TEN application would be appropriate on this occasion.
- A previous event held at the premises on the 26th of August 2018in August 2018 resulted in 3 noise complaints being received by the Authority.

I trust that the above is of interest should you have any further queries please do not hesitate to contact me on 01269 598262. Additionally you are entitled to submit a TEN application to which I would object to which then would be heard and decided by the Licensing Sub-committee.

Noise Monitoring

Location- Living room of 1 Ponside, Johnstown, Carmarthen

Date – 28/06/2019 to 03/07/2019

Graph 1 and Graph 2 – These are just examples of the noise levels measured at the property on Friday the 28/06/19, which is the day before the event. Noise at 14:00 to 14:20 (Graph 1) fluctuate between 30 and 40 dBA_{L_{Aeq}500ms} where the average noise levels over a 20 minute period (LA_{Eq} 20mins) was 32.3 dBA. Noise levels measured at 21:16 to 21:36 (Graph 2) fluctuate between mid 30's and mid 40's dBA_{L_{Aeq}500ms}. There are some instantaneous noise levels that reach a peak of approximately 60dBA_{L_{Aeq}500ms}. The average noise levels over the 20 minute period (LA_{Eq} 20mins) was 40.2 dBA

Graph 3 – This is a graph of the first noise recording taken on Saturday the 29/06/19 which was at 15:36. The noise levels fluctuates between levels around 40dBA to levels of around 70dBA. The average noise levels over the 4 minute period (LA_{Eq} 4mins) was 62.5 dBA. The audio recording contains music from a singer with backing band of drum set, electric guitar and a double bass which was clearly audible and is the dominant noise on the recording. There is very little people noise as the majority of the noise is from music. Towards the end of the recording there is some extraneous noises heard from the occupier and his family, however the music noise still remains the dominant source of noise.

Graph 4 – This is a graph of the noise levels taken on Saturday the 29/06/19 from 15:30 to 16:30. The graph shows that noise levels do fluctuate as expected and noise levels vary from 35dBA to levels of around 80dBA. The average noise levels over the 60 minute period (LA_{Eq} 60mins) was 65.6 dBA. This illustrates that the noise levels shown in Graph 3 was not an isolated situation. The graph contains 6 audio recordings over the 60 minute period.

- 1st audio has previously been described in Graph 3.
- 2nd audio contains music from a drum set, electric guitar and a double bass no singing just an instrumental section. There are some movement noises from inside the occupiers property but music is clearly the dominant source of noise. Toward to the end of 2nd audio there is a different song being played.
- 3rd Audio is a male singer playing with a band (drums set, bass and lead guitar) the genre seems to be jazz/blues. Music is clear and every word being sung can be clearly identified. When music ends you can hear people clapping and the male singer speaking to crowd.
- 4th audio unable to distinguish if singer is male or female however playing with a band (drums set, bass and lead guitar) and the genre as before seems to be jazz/blues . Music is clear especially the drums and bass which are loud. There is some extraneous noise audible on the audio however that is secondary to the music.
- 5th music playing seems loud on audio, when the music stops the levels drop from 65db to around 47dB. There is some noise from the occupier when the music is not playing. However as soon as the band restarts the noise levels jump up from 47dBA to 65+dBA and the noise from occupiers are no longer audible.
- 6th The audio seems extremely loud with a similar genre of music being played as previous recordings but levels are up and over 70dBA, especially when the lead guitarist does a solo. The noise levels do decrease slightly when singer resumes. Also on audio there is some noise from the occupier and his family . However the music noise is the main source of noise .

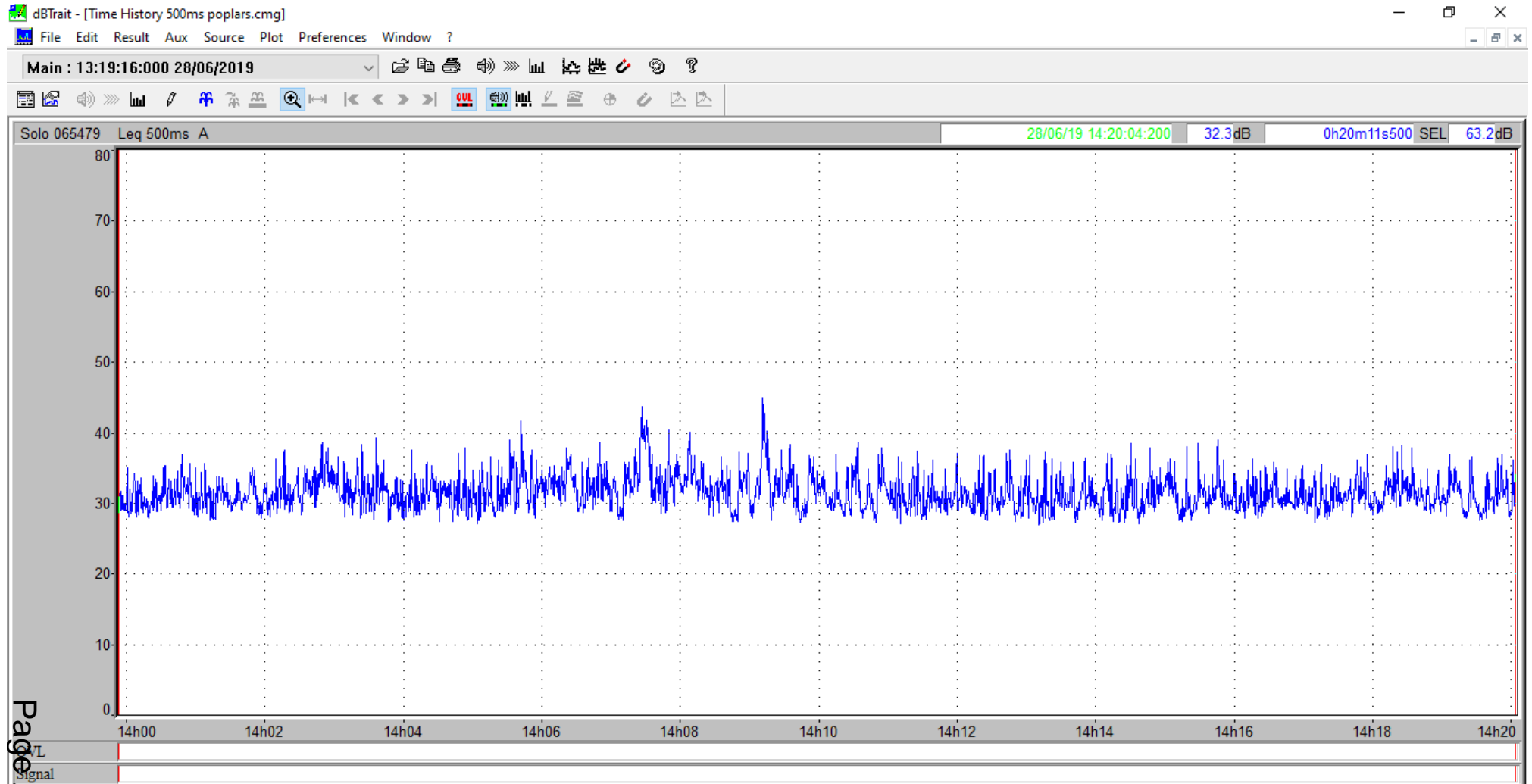

Graph 5 - This is a graph of the noise levels taken on Saturday the 29/06/19 from 21:30 to 22:00. The graph shows that noise levels do fluctuate as expected and noise levels vary from levels of 40 dBA to levels exceeding 70dBA. The average noise levels over the 30 minute period (LAEq 30mins) was 60.8 dBA. This Graph contains 5 separate audio recordings.

- 1st audio recording contains a singer and guitar singing “Hi Ho Silver Lining” fairly loud also noted that customer noise is also more prevalent. There is some extraneous noise from the occupiers. When music stops the noise levels fall to around 50dBA, the noise audible then is from both the occupiers and customer. When the singer resumes it seems to be quieter but still between 55dBA to 60 dBA.
- 2nd recording contains customer noise and a guitar being played the singer seems quieter can hear him sing and then speak on his mic in between each song but customer noise is becoming just as loud as the singer. The Noise Level is around 55 to 60 dBA.
- 3d recording contains same singer seems clearer on this audio especially the lead guitar. There is some extraneous noise from occupiers. Singer sings “sometimes i feel i've got to run away” and Im able to hear customers join and singing with artist. Level are around 60dBA when this song is being played, there is some customer noises also present.
- 4th recording contains same song as the 3rd audio. When song stops I can hear the noise from customers. Levels are around 60 to 65 dB with singer and around 50 to 55dBA when singer stops and speaks on the mic.
- 5th recording contains audio of a singer same as in 4th recordings singing Neil Diamond “Sweet Caroline” can clearly hear customers joining in with the chorus. When singer stops can hear him saying “ok one more song”. The levels are between 60 and 70 dBA when he is singing.

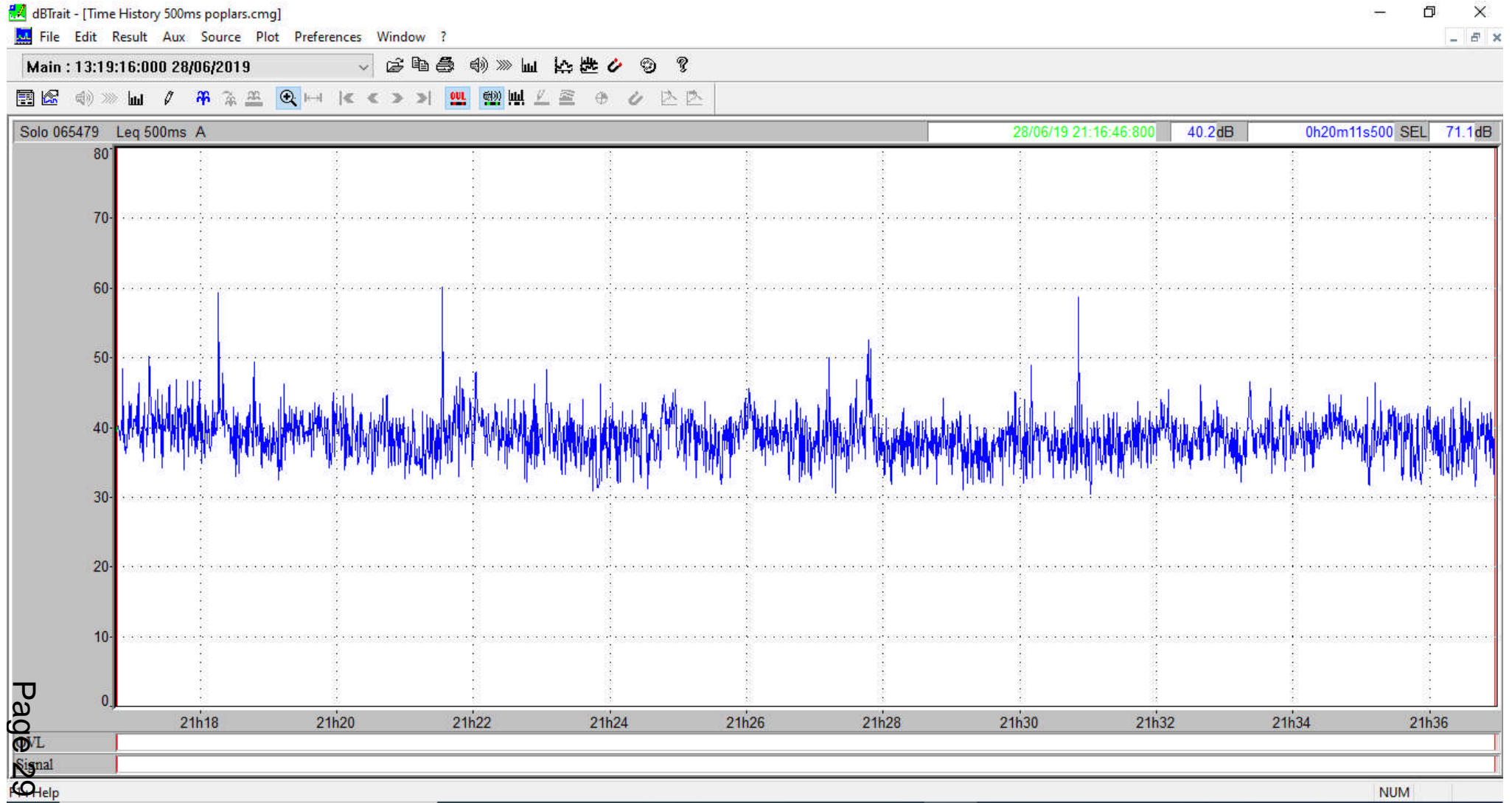

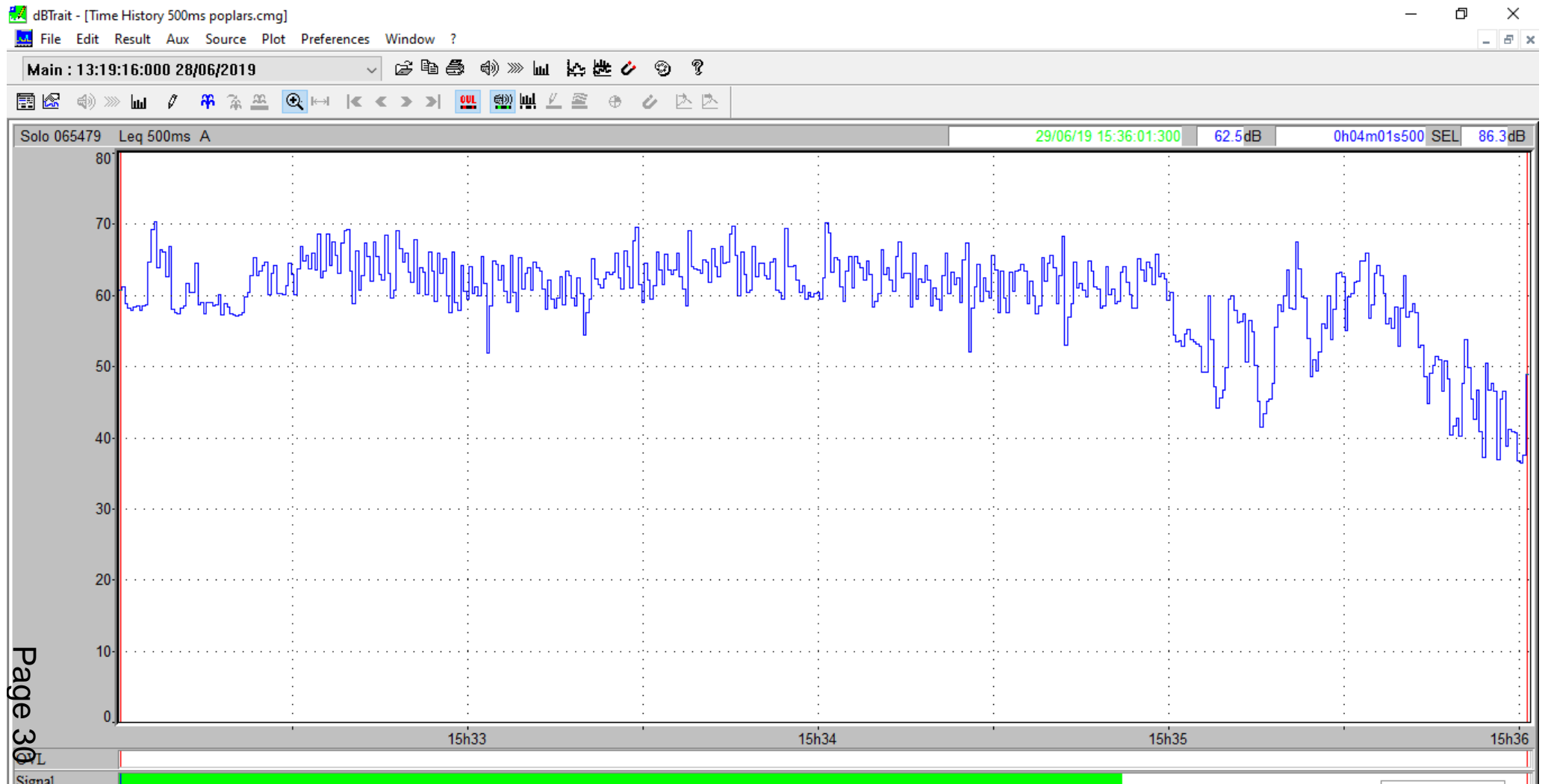

File Note

Date - : 29/06/19

21:00. Met with Ruth Thomas, Environmental Health Officer and walked to the complainant's property at 1 Pondside which is located directly next door to the Poplars.

On arriving at Pondside, I could see and hear a live band playing in the marquee located at the side of the Poplars. The music was clearly audible. We walked to 1 Pondside and spoke with the complainants Mr and Mrs Wyatt. Mrs Wyatt took us to the living room where our Noise Monitoring equipment was positioned. Mrs Wyatt mentioned that the noise from the event was especially loud at approximately 14:30. Mrs Wyatt mentioned that the noise was so loud that they had struggled to have a conversation between the family as the noise was pulsing through the house. Mr Wyatt then arrived and reiterated what his wife had stated. He confirmed that he had taken audio records throughout the day.

Whilst at the property I enquired with Mr and Mrs Wyatt that if the landlord of the Poplars adhered to all the conditions within his License, would they find the noise from the Poplars tolerable. Both Mr and Mrs Wyatt stated that they were fully aware that they lived next door to a pub and expected some noise and if the landlord adhered to his conditions they would find the situation tolerable, however this was not the case.

Mr and Mrs Wyatt stated that the noise had subsided as the afternoon evening went on but they believed that the volume had dropped as the artists performing were now tailored towards an older audience. Mr and Mrs Wyatt stated that a lot of the younger patrons had left the pub. Nevertheless, both Mr and Mrs Wyatt stated that there was nowhere they could go within their home to escape the noise.

At the time of our arrival at approximately 21:10, the event being held at the Poplars was clearly audible within the living room of 1 Pondside. When the window was open and it was difficult to hold a conversation at a normal level. We proceeded to close the window and although the noise level dropped, the music continued to be clearly audible within the living room area although I was now able to hold a conversation at normal level.

We left the premises at 21:30 to attend another visit but confirmed that we would call back later in the evening.

When we returned to the area at 22:00. Live music had stopped playing, but I could hear loud amplified music being played through a speaker believed to be located somewhere within the marquee. The noise was clearly audible in the area. The music ceased at 22:30, where the music was played from within the public house premises, although it could be heard from outside the premises at a low level. There continued to be a number of patrons within the beer garden at the front of the public house, some of which were quite loud in their manner.

The level of noise witnessed at the complainants property was not at a level that I would deem acceptable and therefore as mentioned to you during our conversation on the 5th of July 2019, it is likely that any further Temporary Event Notice (TEN) applications received would result in an objection from the Environmental Health Team. This is due to the fact that based on the above mentioned noise monitoring we believe that the "Prevention of a Public Nuisance" objective will not be met.

Whilst considering the above and should wish to submit a TEN application for any future events then I would strongly advise you to submit the application early enough in order to enable the application to be objected to and heard in a Licensing Sub Committee for them to determine the application. Should you wish to receive further advice on this process please do not hesitate to contact the Licencing Section in order that they can provide you with the appropriate advice. I would however strongly advise you from submitting a Late TEN as this would result in an objection without the option of having a Licensing Hearing.

The aim of the review process would be to attach some conditions to the Premises Licence, these in my opinion would better promote the Public Safety and Prevention of Public Nuisance objectives of the Licensing Act 2003. The conditions proposed would be based on the points below

3. Doors to be provided with self-closures

The issue is that the public house has opened and they are using the car park as a beer garden there is over crowding no control we are getting damage in the area only last night the fence outside the park was broken by clients they are not being considerate of local residents they stay in the pub till late then we are subjected to them going in the children's park where the volume stays at a unexceptionable level as .we have had the clients coming round the back of the property as the property between us and the pub is not in use at the moment but on that note the landlord of

the pub uses the house next door to us as his own property as own for years he has left his bottle bin in the drive and now he's again parking his cars in it because he's using the car park as his pub

but we the residents have to put up with people sitting on our cars and causing damage in the past the users of the pub have kicked off both of my mirrors and done lots of minor damage to my car we have a second one in the drive which is much newer and I'm waiting daily for the damage to that and this is only a summary of the issues I'm dealing with and as you can imagine it's getting to me I am a Bit engineer so the lack of sleep is going to impact on my safety in work please help



All requirements and restrictions under The Regulations will be subject to review by the Welsh Ministers every 21 days.

This Premises Improvement Notice is being issued under Schedule 8(1) of The Regulations.

Appeals –

- (1) A person to whom a Premises Improvement Notice or Premises Closure Notice is issued may appeal to a magistrates' court against the notice.
- (2) An appeal must be made—
 - (a) by way of complaint for an order, and in accordance with the Magistrates' Courts Act 1980, and
 - (b) within 7 days after the day the notice is issued.

- (7) An appeal by either party against the decision of a magistrates' court on an appeal under this section may be brought to the Crown Court.

 - (b) remit the case to the magistrates' court to dispose of in accordance with directions given by the Crown Court.

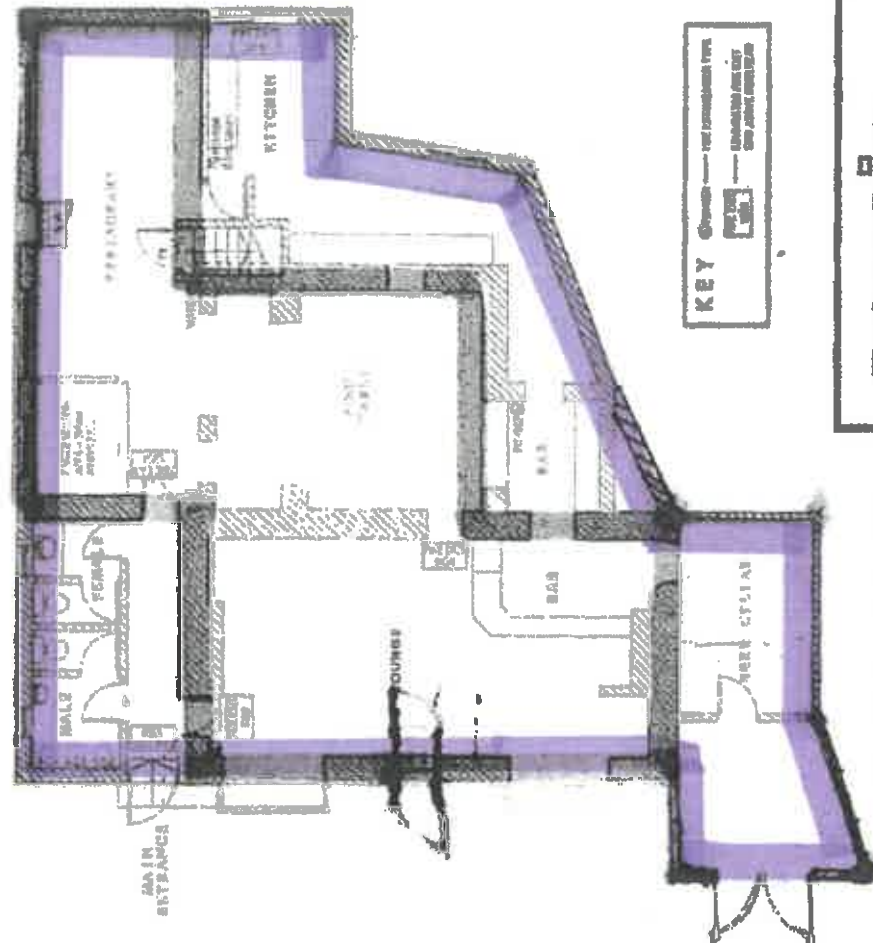

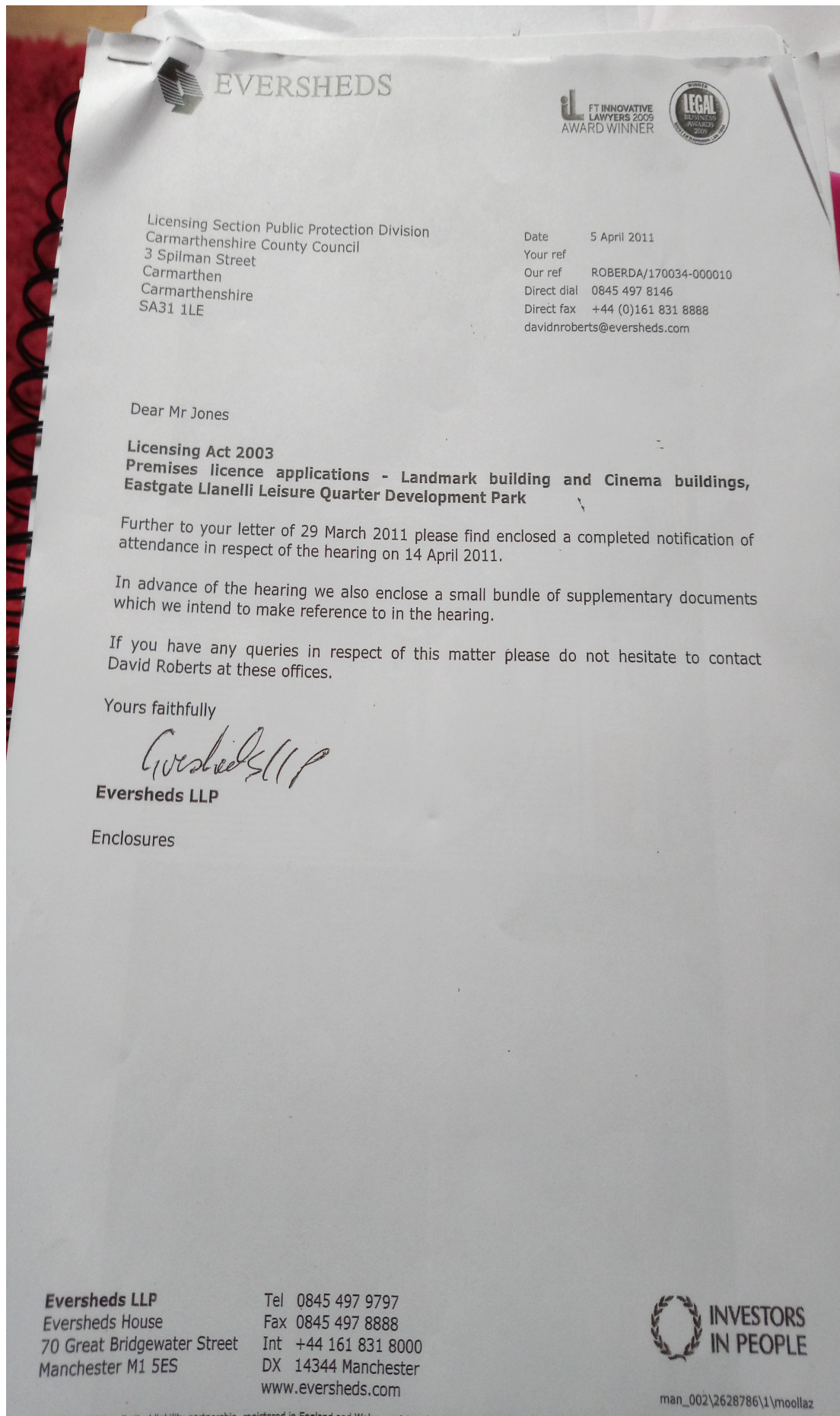



On Fridays & Saturdays, no customers will be allowed to enter the premises after 1am, regardless of whether these customers are newly arriving or existing customers going outside the premises for a cigarette.

SIA door staff will start their shifts every Friday & Saturday at 9pm also including Bank Holiday Sundays.

The DPS is a member of the local pub watch scheme (BOBB - Behave or Be Banned).

At the very least we will have a ratio of 1 door supervisor per 50 customers.

SIA staff will use entry clickers to control the capacity entering the premises to prevent overcrowding and patrons possibly becoming aggressive through accidental jostling.

Alternatives to glass drinking vessels should be considered to prevent glassware being used as an assault weapon, particularly during promoted events. i.e. plastic shot cups etc.

Trained glass collecting staff will be on shift to collect all empty glassware as soon as its use is no longer needed to prevent glassware being used as a weapon.

Public Safety.**General Safety of Staff and Customers.**

If a customer is looking highly intoxicated, they will be refused the sale of alcohol and a member of staff will ask a SIA trained staff to remove the person from the premises helping to prevent the beginning of what could turn into an aggressive act from a person who is not in control of their actions.

A full risk assessment considering public safety is in place on the premises to identify potential hazards posed to staff or customers and setting out precautions to manage the hazards.

A risk assessment is regularly reviewed at least every 12 months.

First aid boxes are available at the premises and maintained with sufficient in date stock.

A recognised qualification in first aid is held by at least one member of staff who will be on duty at all operational times.

Drug use or Drink Spiking.

A zero-tolerance policy to the use of drugs in the premises is in place

Posters are displayed throughout the premises to remind customers of the zero-tolerance policy.

SIA Staff will refuse entry to anyone who appears to be showing signs of drug use and will contact the emergency services in appropriate circumstances.

If such cases arise, an entry will be made in an incident logbook.

**Safety of the Customers
while leaving the premises.**

A duty of care policy regarding persons suffering adversely from the effects of drugs is in place at the premises.

The policy includes drug awareness training for all staff so that they can recognise the effects of controlled drugs and provide medical attention where necessary.

All staff are briefed on the policy. A record will be kept of the date and name of person trained.

If a customer suspects that their drink has been spiked, staff will report it to the police immediately. A process for this is clearly set out in a duty of care logbook.

A 'chill out' area will be provided by staff at the rear entrance which will be cooler and quieter than rest of venue, while waiting for emergency services to arrive.

Help discourage drink driving by promoting schemes such as Designated Driver, with notices clearly displayed premises throughout the premises.

Display information to customers with regards to safe options for travelling home such as Taxi's.

Information will include access to licensed taxi cabs or licensed private hire vehicles, the location of taxi ranks.

Provide a free taxi phone service and a safe waiting area for customers inside the premises.

Prevention of Public Nuisance.

Offer a 'chill out' period at the end of an evening which will allow a slow dispersal from the premises allowing door staff to gain a handle on problem individuals, preventing arguing over taxis or congregation and clashes around nearby venues.

All lighting inside the premises will be turned on 30mins before the end of an evening to affect the alertness of customers before they leave the premises.

Increased external lighting is put in place to provide added safety for customers as they leave the premises.

A noise management policy in place that sets out sound attenuation measures to prevent or control music, singing and speech noise breakout from Premises.

Live Artists & DJs perform inside the VIP area which is situated well away from the entry/exit doors, dampening the volume leaving the premises.

Live Artists & DJ's will use the in-house equipment so that noise levels can be set to the correct limit keeping noise to the correct levels at all times, A sound limiter will be in place to determine the acceptable sound levels and will be used at all times.

A diary log will be kept to register noise levels on Fridays & Saturdays for proof that policy is being adhered to. This record will be kept and made available for inspection by the Licencing Authority or Environmental Health Authority.

Entry/Exit doors will be kept shut at all times, only opened to leave customers enter or exit the premises to avoid noise breakout as much as possible.

Live Acts or DJs are made aware of the policy in advance of any performance.

**Prevention of Public
Nuisance outside the
premises.**

Doors are fitted with self-closing devices.

Only the premises licence holder and the designated premises supervisor will have access to the sound limiting device.

All entertainment facilities such as DJ booth, stage and loudspeakers are away from doors and windows. All speakers are mounted on ceiling and facing in an inwards/downwards direction away from windows and doors.

Noise monitoring will actively be carried out on a regular basis and in particular when a new form of entertainment is introduced at the premises, when alterations are made to the premises or when a complaint is made directly to the venue.

A contact telephone number is available to residents which they can use to report noise disturbances to a responsible person at the venue as and when they occur. The phone line is always available while the licence is in use.

All Live acts are acoustic acts only, this will make a huge difference in the noise levels leaving the premises when doors are opened. No more than a Trio Act is permitted to play at the premises at any one time.

From 10pm on Fridays and Saturdays, only 15 persons at any one time will be allowed outside the premises for a cigarette.

Entry/Exit Points have been moved to the rear doors of the premises, an additional 30 yards away from residents.

The protection of children from harm.

Barriers will be in place every Friday & Saturday from 7pm until close & set up to help direct customers leaving the premises in the opposite direction from the residents' homes and directly to the Taxi Rank that sits at the rear of the premises.

Mobile Cigarette bins are in place at the entry/exit doors and posters are on door windows to promote customers using the bins provided.

Outside Seating is removed, therefore customers have no where to sit and chat while smoking cigarettes, resulting in cigarette periods being a lot shorter.

Be sure that notices requesting customers to respect the needs of the residents and to use the area quietly are displayed.

No person under the age of 18 are allowed into the premises after 9pm unless an organised/private event is in progress for under 18 year olds.

No children under the age of 16 are allowed into the premises after 9pm unless they are attending a pre-booked function or event and accompanied by an adult.

The 'Challenge 21' scheme to be in place at the premises with notices and posters to clearly be always displayed near the entry area and bar area.

No person under the age of 18 shall be employed whether paid or unpaid for the purpose of serving alcohol.
