EVENT SUPPORT FUND APPLICATIONS

1. BRIEF SUMMARY OF PURPOSE OF REPORT.

As part of a series of actions to grow the contribution of events and festivals in Carmarthenshire, £20,000.00 has been approved to provide an Event Support Fund Scheme aimed at providing financial assistance to events in the county that can demonstrate that they can make a contribution to the Tourism, Community and Economic strategic aims. As of 1st March 2018, £2,500 has already been committed from the 18/19 fund whilst the following applications have been received and assessed against the criteria with recommendations listed below

Financial Year 2018/19

- The Laugharne Weekender 2018: Recommended support £1,000.00
- Llandeilo Literature Festival 2018: Recommend support £1,000.00
- Open Air Cinema: Recommended support £0

Total sum recommended **£2,000.00** Scheme amount remaining in 18/19: £15,500.00

2. OTHER OPTIONS AVAILABLE AND THEIR PROS AND CONS

Sponsorship has been provided in previous years to the Laugharne Weekender especially during the Dylan Thomas celebration in 2014. As an event of national exposure to a cultural audience, this could have attracted more support and tourism assistance such as accommodation and public relations if the application had been received much earlier. It is also noted that the event has sold out. Further benefits can be gained through using the Event Network Circle especially in seeking a commercial sponsor income for both Laugharne and Llandeilo events respectively.

A stronger set of tourism promotional actions needs to be implemented in both events including more tangible plans to increase the business relationship between the events and accommodation providers. The Open Air Cinema is a proposition that in our experience carries risk and an application could be strengthened if more detail had been provided on how the area would benefit and it would make an impact to the tourism sector / year of the sea theme

1. Policy, Crime & Disorder and Equalities

The County Council's Transformations Regeneration Plan 2015-2030 highlights the aim to *transform the overall economic, environmental, cultural and social well-being of Carmarthenshire.* The Events Support Scheme as one of a set of aligned actions to grow events in the County by the County Council will make an impact to events that can in turn improve the contribution events and festivals make to the economy and communities in Carmarthenshire.

A criteria for assessment in this scheme is the contribution the applicant's events can make to the Heritage and Culture of their community including the positive use of the Welsh Language throughout the communication and delivering event activities through the medium of Welsh.

2. Finance

The funding for this scheme has been provided through core funds from the Marketing & Media section of the County Council. The total agreed sum for the scheme is set at £20,000 for the financial year 2018 / 2019.

3. Risk Management Issues

As a third party grant, the responsibility for successful event delivery is with the applicant who under the terms of the scheme are only allowed to make a claim after the event has occurred.
