**3. PUBLIC HEALTH (MINIMUM PRICE FOR ALCOHOL) (WALES)**

The Chair welcomed to the meeting Mr David Jones, Trading Standards National Co-ordinator.

The Committee thereupon received a presentation providing an overview of the Legislation on Public Health (Minimum Price For Alcohol) (Wales). Key points covered included:

**4. MR MARK MORRIS SMITH - APPLICATION TO RENEW A HACKNEY CARRIAGE/PRIVATE HIRE DUAL DRIVERS LICENCE**

The Committee considered an application from Mr Mark Morris Smith of 6 Cadifor Street, Carmarthen for the renewal of a Hackney Carriage/Private Hire Dual Driver's Licence.

The Committee interviewed Mr Smith with regards to his application and the issues raised by the Senior Licensing Officer.

The Senior Licensing Officer recommended that Mr Smith's application be granted with a warning as to his future conduct.

**UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED that, in line with the Council's guidelines, the application submitted by Mr Mark Morris Smith for the renewal of his Hackney Carriage/Private Hire Dual Driver's Licence be granted with a warning as to his future conduct.**

**5. MR LESLIE ALBERT SYDNEY CURLE - HACKNEY CARRIAGE/PRIVATE HIRE DUAL DRIVERS LICENCE**

**7. MR DAVID KENNETH JONES - HACKNEY CARRIAGE/PRIVATE HIRE DUAL DRIVERS LICENCE**

The Committee was informed that Mr David Kenneth Jones of 37 Pontardulais Road, Tycroes, Ammanford, was a licensed hackney carriage/private hire dual driver with the Authority.

The Committee interviewed Mr Jones with regards to his licence and the issues raised by the Senior Licensing Officer.

The Senior Licensing Officer recommended that Mr Jones' Hackney Carriage / Private Hire Dual Drivers Licence be suspended for 14 days.

**UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED to retire into private session in order to receive legal advice pursuant to Paragraph 16 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972.**

Following the adjournment, the Committee reconvened to advise of its decision.

**RESOLVED that Mr David Kenneth Jones' Hackney Carriage/Private Hire Dual Drivers Licence be not suspended, but that Mr Jones be issued with a final warning as to his future conduct.**

**Reason**

On the evidence presented, the Committee was satisfied that there was no reasonable cause to suspend the licence.

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### Costau goryfed alcohol Costs of excessive alcohol consumption

- Bu 535 o farwolaethau a oedd yn gysylltiedig ag alcohol yng Nghymru yn 2018
- Bu 60,000 o dderbyniadau i'r ysbtyr a oedd yn gysylltiedig ag alcohol yng Nghymru yn 2018/19

- Mae model Sheffield yn amcangyfrif mai cyfanswm cost gymdeithasol gyffredinol camddefnyddio alcohol yng Nghymru yfdd £16.6bn dros gyfnod o 20 mlynedd
- "Mae isafbris uned am alcohol yn "rhan bwysig" o'r ymdrechion i leihau niwed sy'n gysylltiedig ag alcohol" – Vaughan Gething, 13<sup>th</sup> March 2018
- 8% of 11 to 16 year olds in Wales drink alcohol at least once a week. – risk from physical injury, sexual exploitation, unwanted pregnancy, STDs, danger to emerging brain faculty & long-term memory, impact on education, higher trends of alcohol dependence in adulthood and a wider range of other adverse consequences.
- The Sheffield model estimates the overall societal cost of alcohol misuse in Wales to be £16.6bn over 20 years.
- "Minimum unit price for alcohol to be 'major part' of efforts to reduce alcohol-related harm" – Vaughan Gething, 13<sup>th</sup> March 2018

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### Deddf lechyd y Cyhoedd (Isafbris am Alcohol) (Cymru)

### The Public Health (Minimum Price for Alcohol) (Wales) Act

Nod:

- diogelol iechyd yfwyr pergyllus a niweidol sy'n dueddol o yfed symiau uwch o gynhyrchniadau radh sy'n cynnwys lefelau alcohol uchel.
- er mai dim ond 26% o'r boblogaeth sy'n yfed alcohol yw yfwyr risgau cynyddol a risgau uchel, maent yn yfed 72% o'r holl alcohol ac yn gyfrifol am 65% o'r holl wariant ar alcohol.

Aims to:

- protect the health of harmful and hazardous drinkers who tend to consume greater amounts of low-cost and high-alcohol content products.
- whilst increasing and high risk drinkers combined constitute only 26% of the drinker population, they consume 72% of all alcohol and account for 65% of all spending on alcohol.



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### Y Bobl Dan Sylw Target Drinkers

- Mae yfwyr niweidol yn prynu bron i hanner (46%) o'u halcohol am lai na 50c fesul uned, 4% o'r boblogaeth sy'n yfed alcohol yw'r rhain, ac maent yn yfed 27% o'r holl alcohol sy'n cael ei yfed yng Nghymru.
- Mae yfwyr cymedrol yn prynu llai na chwarter (22%) o'u halcohol am lai na 50c fesul uned.
- Harmful drinkers purchase almost half (46%) of their alcohol for less than 50p per unit. They account for 4% of the drinker population, and they drink 27% of all alcohol consumed in Wales.
- Moderate drinkers purchase less than a quarter (22%) of their alcohol for less than 50p per unit.



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## Y Bobl Dan Sylw Target Drinkers

- Mae 0.6% o'r boblaetha sy'n yfed alcohol yn yfwyri niweidiol yn yr ardal oedd mwyaf difrifledig, ac mae model Sheffield yn amcangyfrif y byddant yn profi 45% o'r marwolaethau sy'n gysylltiedig ag alcohol y gellir eu hosgoi a 24% o'r derbyniadau i'r ysbyty sy'n gysylltiedig ag alcohol y gellir eu hosgoi.
- Amcangyfrifir y bydd Isafbris Uned o 50c yn osgoi 66 o farwolaethau a 1,281 o dderbyniadau i'r ysbyty bob blwyddyn.
- Harmful drinkers in the most deprived areas make up 0.6% of the drinker population, the modelling estimates that they will experience 45% of the averted alcohol-attributable deaths and 24% of the averted alcohol-attributable hospital admissions
- A 50p MUP is estimated to avoid 66 deaths and 1,281 hospital admissions per year.








## Expected impact (not in poverty)

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## Pwerau Gorfodi Awdurdod Lleol Local Authority Enforcement Powers

- Rhaid ystyried pa gamau gorfodi i'w cymryd yn flynyddol gan ystyried yr amcanion i wella iechyd y cyhoedd a diogelu plant rhag niwed
- Ymweld â safleoedd i archwilio (gwarant ar gyfer safle domestig) a gwneid Pryniannau Prawf
- Ymchwilio i gwynnion yngylch troseddau honedig
- Cymryd unrhyw gamau eraill gyda golwg ar leihau troseddau o'r fath
- Must consider annually what enforcement to undertake and must have regard to the objectives of improving public health and protecting children from harm.
- Enter premises to inspect (warrant for domestic) and make Test Purchases
- Investigate complaints of alleged offences
- Take any other steps with a view to reducing the occurrence of such offences.



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## Pwerau Gorfodi Awdurdod Lleol Local Authority Enforcement Powers

- Rhisiadau Cosb Benodol - £200 mewn 29 diwrnod (lleihau i £150 os yw'n cael ei dalu o fewn 15 diwrnod)
- Cadw derbynebau Hysbysiadau Cosb Benodol er mwyn eu defnyddio i orfod i'r drefn
- Erlyn o bosibl - uchafswm dinwy Lefel 3 (£1,000), amddiffyniad diwydrwyd dylawyd, apêl (21 diwrnod)
- Trosedd berthnasol yn Atolien 4 o Ddeddf Trwyddedu 2003, a all gael ei hystyried gan Awdurdod Trwyddedu wrth wneud penderfyniadau ynglyn â rhoi/adnewyddu/diddymu trwyddedau personol
- Issue FPNs - £200 in 29 days (reduced to £150 if paid within 15 days)
- Keep receipts of FPNs to use to enforce regime
- May prosecute - max fine Level 3 (£1,000), due diligence defence, Appeal 21days
- Relevant offence in Schedule 4 to the 2003 Licensing Act, which can be taken into consideration by a Licensing Authority when making decisions on granting/renewing/revoking personal licences.

- Safonau Masnach Cymru neu Gwyfryddwyr Diogelu'r Cyhoedd (Cymru) yn debygol o ddylunio cwrtiau archwilio i Awdurdod Lleol (yn selliedig ar nifer y safleoedd trwyddedol sy'n cael "gwerthu alocioli i'w yfed oddi ar y safle" yn eu hardaloedd)
- Ar ôl eu cwblhau, mae angen i'r Awdurdodau Lleol anfon anfoneb at Safonau Masnach Cymru gyda rhestr o safleoedd yr ymhwelwyd a hwy
- Safonau Masnach Cymru i dalu @ £61.32 fusol safle yr ymhwelwyd ag ef
- WG agreed DPPW proposal for enforcement
- WG will fund £300k in total over 3 years
  - £200k in year 1, £70k in year 2 and £30k in year 3
- TS Wales or DPPW is likely to allocate a quota of inspections to LAs (based on the number of premises licensed for "off sales" in their areas)
- On completion, LA to invoice TS Wales with list of premises visited
