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	<p>Following the concerns raised in relation to the objections regarding the loss of privacy and the elevation of the development, it was proposed that the Committee undertake a site inspection in order to gain a better understanding of the impact on the adjacent properties. This was duly seconded.</p> <p>In order to seek legal advice, the Chair adjourned the meeting for 15 minutes at 11:45am. At 12:00pm, the Committee reconvened and in light of the objections, it was proposed that the Committee undertake a site visit subject to the Welsh Government Covid/Regulations and following a risk assessment undertaken by this Authority.</p>
