3. DETERMINATION OF PLANNING APPLICATIONS

3.1 RESOLVED that the following planning applications be refused for the reasons detailed within the Report of the Head of Place and Sustainability:-

PL/04317	Local need dwelling at Land adjacent to Pen Rhos, Llanelli, SA14 7HA (NOTE: During the discussion on this item Councillor G. B Thomas declared an interest on the basis he owned land on which his children, if they returned to the area, could apply to build homes on. He remained in the meeting but abstained from voting)	
	Representations were received from the local members in support of the application replicating the submission detailed within the report of the Head of Place and Sustainability. Those included the applicant's personal circumstances and ties with the area, the applicant was unaware of the need to be on the councils' housing register, there were no suitable plots/dwellings for sale in the area, the need to retain young families in the rural areas, the applicant had stated the site was within a group of houses, there were other residential and commercial buildings in close proximity and there were other local needs applications which had been granted planning consent e.g W/36522 at Abernant where the approved dwelling was larger than currently proposed for the application site.
