

- 3. Footage from the CCTV system must be capable of being recorded onto an easily downloadable format.
- Images recorded by the CCTV system shall be retained for a period of not less than 31 days and shall be provided to the Police or an authorised Officer of the Licensing Authority upon request.
- 5. All images recorded by the CCTV system shall denote an accurate date and time.
- 6. The system must be registered with the Information Commissioner (Tel 0303 123 1113 or email registration@ico.org.uk).
- 7. A challenge 25 scheme to be adopted at the premises. There shall be notices displayed at prominent places throughout the premises including at all points of sale to inform customers and remind staff that the premises is operating a "Challenge 25" policy.
- 8. Alcohol can only be sold for consumption in the external area in polycarbonate, plastic or shatterproof glasses.
- 9. No open containers of alcohol shall be removed from the boundary of the premises.
- 10. No person under the age of 18 shall be employed on the premises whether paid or unpaid for the purpose of serving alcohol.

I also refer to 5.6 of the Licensing Policy whereby the Licensing Authority believes that the effective management of licensed premises by suitability experienced and trained staff is essential for the promotion of the four licensing objectives. This is especially relevant to the management of outdoor areas.

The Police believe that the above conditions are necessary and appropriate to promote the Licensing Objectives.

Dear Sirs.

I write to lodge a complaint regarding the proposed use and opening times of Llandybie RFC, Woodfield Road, Llandybie, Ammanford SA18 3UT. Proprietors David Andrew Thomas and Elizabeth Sarah Meiner Thomas.

I live at 1 Heol Marlais, Llandybie, SA18 3UY. I am in poor health. In number 2 is an elderly man in poor health. In number 3 is a young mother with three very young children one of which is a baby less than a year old. In number 4 is an elderly lady. All these flats are situated directly opposite the rugby club. In my view very little thought has gone into the impact these proposals will have on these people or how these proposals will effect people living in surrounding flats and houses.

The rugby club is situated in a very built up residential area where there are many young families close to it of whom have very young children. The proposals suggest that the rugby club will be operated more like a night club. If it was situated in the middle of a town such as Carmarthen or Swansea it would be more acceptable but where it is the proposals are very unacceptable. It's proposed long opening hours with live and recorded music every day are not what you would expect from a small village rugby club.

On the 9 October the rugby club hosted a funeral wake. The attendees could be easily heard in my living room singing inside the club and even more easily talking and laughing outside it. Fortunately this event closed down by 11 o'clock at night the biding of goodnight and increased traffic noise ceased by about 11.15pm. Judging things on this event I am dreading what clearly is going to be a huge noise pollution in one form or another coming from the club for between 12 to 15 hours per day not to mention the increased traffic noise that will inevitably take place.

I urge that these proposals are turned down.
