- 4.2 The objections and comments are summarised in **Appendix 3** along with officer comments.
- 4.3 In response to the submission from the Carmarthenshire Disabled Coalition for Action group, the local elected Members of the County Council have agreed to the retention of one of the disabled parking bays on King Street. It is recommended that only one of the two disabled persons parking bays on King Street is re-designated to a 30minute limited waiting parking bay.
- 4.4 In response to the objection to the proposed restrictions along Heol Spurrell, a site meeting was held on the 13th July 2016 with the Head Teacher, the local Member, and a County Council Traffic Officer. It was agreed at the meeting that the restrictions be implemented. It was also agreed that the restrictions would be reviewed after a period of monitoring. It is recommended that the restrictions are implemented and subject to monitoring.

Disabled badge holders may park in a limited waiting bay for an unlimited period (with a valid badge on display).

The purpose of the 30minute limited waiting period is to facilitate 'shop-and-drop'. There is sufficient provision of short stay (from 1 hour up to 4 hours) and all day parking in nearby John Street and St Peters public car parks.

As per Ref. 1 above, it is recommended that only one of the two disabled persons parking bays on King Street is re-designated to a 30minute limited waiting parking bay.
