# 2. TO SIGN AS A CORRECT RECORD THE DECISION RECORD OF THE MEETING HELD ON THE 7TH JULY 2023

RESOLVED that the decision record of the meeting held on the 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023 be signed as a correct record.

#### 3. APPOINTMENT OF LA GOVERNORS

The Cabinet Member considered applications received for Local Authority Governor vacancies within the county. Nominations had been invited from the Chairperson, Head teacher and Local Member(s) in the case of Primary Schools/the member(s) who were governors in the case of Secondary Schools.

It was noted that Local Authority Governors are appointed for 4 years, and where the vacancy has occurred as a result of an individual's term of office coming to an end, this was noted in the details for that particular person if he/she was seeking appointment.

It was also noted that all County Councillors, when elected, could stipulate which school governing bodies they would sit, and their decision would take preference over 'non-elected' LA Governors. Consequently, County Councillors could nominate to serve as LA Governors on a school that did not have a vacant post and in the event of the governorship becoming oversubscribed, the Council would stipulate which LA Governor was required to stand down.

### APPOINTMENT OF EDUCATION ADMISSIONS FORUM MEMBERS

#### **BRIEF SUMMARY OF PURPOSE OF REPORT**

In accordance with the LA appointment policy for Admissions Forum Members, there is a requirement to review core members and school members of the Forum every 4 years.

A full membership review took place and nominations formally approved in May 2023. It was acknowledged that an additional nomination for a Community representative be re-advertised. A further exercise to recruit an additional Community representation was undertaken in May 2023 via "One Voice Wales which resulted in a single nomination.

Mr Julian Kennedy, Head of Ysgol Dyffryn Taf resigned from the Forum in June 2023 as he has taken up a new headship in another County. An exercise to seek nominations from all Carmarthenshire Secondary Heads was delayed until the start of the new Academic year in September 2023 to ensure all new Heads in post. Only one nomination received.
