3. EVENT SUPPORT PROGRAMME 2017 - 2018

The Executive Board Member considered a report seeking approval for £20,000.00 funding for the launch of an Event Support Fund Scheme aimed at providing financial assistance to events in the county that could demonstrate that they met certain criteria, namely the Tourism, Community and Economic strategic aims. It was anticipated that there would be great demand for what would be a relatively small fund therefore support would only be given to those events which showed clearly evidenced economic outputs.

RESOLVED to approve funding of £20,000.00 for the launch of an Event Support Fund Scheme.
