Section 2: Constituency Activities

Over the last Council's Municipal year I have undertaken 20 surgeries at Ysgol Y Bedol and Garnant Club. I have also held Walkabout surgeries on the following streets:

Over the last Council's Municipal year I have raised via the Council's enquiry system 64 enquiries of matters raised in the Garnant ward, e.g.

Over the last year I have been working with Carmarthenshire County Council, Ysgol y Bedol and Welsh Government on the safe routes funding for Cwmamman. I am pleased that we have received funding of a grant of £180,000. The scheme in Cwmamman includes a new footway along Folland Road, an off road footpath for cyclists and pedestrians along Amman Valley cycle way, and also Zebra crossing outside Ysgol y Bedol and parent wating shelters and cycle racks at the School.

Last year Ysgol y Bedol had solar panels of 50kwp pv system installed and has saved over £10,000 on the School electric bills in the last year.

At the start of this year a new multi-use games area In Cwmamman park was officially opened by the Mayor. I have been working closely with the Town Council who had worked hard to complete this project with cash injection of £50,000 from Wern, £10,000 from Betws Windfarm Community Benefit Fund, a further £10,000 from Welsh Church Fund and the remainder funded by Cwmamman Town Council.

Also this year I officially opened the £17,000 animal project in the garden at Ysgol y Bedol which will make a big difference to the children at Ysgol y Bedol.

The Workmen's Hall, Garnant remains an eyesore. There has been progress with the owners and I have been waiting for a planning application to go into public consultation for the past 6 months.
