Section 53 of the Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981 places a DUTY on the Local Authority to eep the Definitive Map & Statement under continuous review, therefore we have no option ut to process the application and make the Order.		
The landowner may agree to carry out a Public Path Dedication / Creation Order. This is sometimes done as the most expedient way to record a Public Right of Way. It may also allow for the adjustment of the route, where desired / agreed.
