1. BRIEF SUMMARY OF PURPOSE OF REPORT.

As part of a series of actions to grow the contribution of events and festivals in Carmarthenshire, £20,000.00 has been approved to provide an event support fund scheme aimed at providing financial assistance to events in the county that can demonstrate that they can make a contribution to the Tourism, Community and Economic strategic aims. As of 31st May 2019, £15,472.00 has already been committed from the 19/20 fund

The following applications has been received and assessed against the criteria with the following recommendation;

Llansteffan Mock Mayor 2019: Recommended support £400.00

British Paracycling Road and Time Trial Championships: Recommended support £1,000.00

Total amount recommended £1,400.00
