- 1. The Council's procedure document has been amended in accordance with the suggestions made and is attached for approval.
- 2. Dip sampling of internet usage has been undertaken for the period October to December 2019. No evidence of unauthorised directed surveillance was revealed.
- 3. Arrangements are in the process of being made to hold the 'table-top' exercises suggested.
- 4. In addition a register of RIPA queries was established on 30/09/19 and since then a total of 7 queries have been received regarding use of covert surveillance powers and in each case advice given which has avoided the need for covert surveillance to be undertaken.
