Following the application of the public interest test it was **UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED** pursuant to the Act referred to in minute 4 above, not to publicise the content of the report as it contained exempt information relating to a particular individual. The public interest test in this matter related to the fact that the report included personal information relating to the applicant. Disclosure would support transparency and accountability in the decision-making process, however, on balance the public interest in maintaining confidentiality outweighed the public interest in disclosure because of the need to protect the identity of the applicant and the family.

The Chair welcomed officers from Legal, Environment and Education & Children's Services to the meeting. The Panel was reminded that consideration of the application had been deferred at its previous meeting held on the 11th June, 2021 (1.15p.m) for arrangements to be made for the walking route from A.W-R's home address to the designated school to be re-assessed

The Panel having been advised that it had not been possible to undertake the route re-assessment to date,

UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED that consideration of the appeal be further deferred for arrangements to be made for the walking route from A.W-R.'s home address to the designated school to be re-assessed.
