# LLANELLI SHOPMOBILITY

The County Council has supported the Llanelli Shopmobility scheme since 2011. The current funding is an annual arrangement renewed each August.

The Llanelli scheme provides a valuable service for the mobility impaired to access the town and is important in helping the town recover from the impacts of the Covid pandemic.

The scheme is mainly reliant on the County Council's financial support and an annual grant of £14,650 is normally provided which is funded from the County Council's Community Transport element of the Bus Services Support Grant.

Shopmobility supports the County Council's updated *Corporate Strategy 2018-2023* which includes specific recognition of the importance of inclusive mobility in:

- Providing integrated and affordable access for businesses, for residents and visitors can stimulate economic development, reductions in deprivation and social exclusion and an increase in well-being.
- Sustaining access to services will deliver improvements in health and well-being for all sections of the community e.g. that includes walking, cycling, passenger and road transport.

The Council has set aside funding to fund a further twelve months support.

It is therefore recommended that the Llanelli Shopmobility scheme is supported with funding of £14,650 for a further twelve months from August 2021.

Should there be any surplus funding at the end of their financial year it would be relatively modest and reinvested in supporting the operation of the service.

**Recommendation:** That Llanelli Shopmobility be supported with a further grant of £14,650 for a further twelve month period commencing August 2021.
