APPOINTMENT OF EDUCATION ADMISSIONS MEMBERS

In accordance with the LA appointment policy for Admissions Forum Members, there is a requirement to review core members and school members of the Forum every 4 years.

The last full membership review took place in Autumn 2017, a review is necessary in Autumn 2021. The renewal of membership would normally fall in sync with the County Council members election, however due to the Welsh Government elections in 2021, local Council elections were delayed a year to 2022.
