# **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:- EBM Communities 12th May 2016**

### Establishment of a Tackling Poverty Advisory Panel.

In 2013 the Welsh Government requested that all Local Authorities in Wales appoint an Anti-Poverty Champion charged with improving the understanding of the poverty agenda and to support and challenge their organisation to deliver the necessary action. Cllr. Pam Palmer was appointed in this role. Work was initiated to identify existing tackling poverty work across the Authority which was presented to the Policy & Resources Scrutiny Committee in February 2015.

The Scrutiny Committee requested the establishment of a cross party members task and finish focus group to look at:

- Improving coordination of tackling poverty initiatives delivered by the Authority;
- Identifying gaps in existing provision; and
- Identify priorities for tackling poverty going forward.

In order to fulfil these objectives and as a result of the work of the Focus Group an action plan will be developed to capture existing tackling poverty work across the organisation and to ensure that future programmes are designed with this action plan. The main aim of the proposed Advisory Panel will be to advise and support the Executive Board Member with responsibility for Tackling Poverty.

The objectives of the Tackling Poverty Advisory Panel are to:

- Develop a co-ordinated response by Carmarthenshire County Council to poverty in the county;
- Support the identification of needs of communities in relation to poverty;
- Consider gaps in tackling poverty support and potential means of addressing these;
- Support the identification of future priorities for Carmarthenshire County Council in terms of tackling poverty;
- Monitor the Tackling Poverty Action Plan;
- Explore opportunities for embedding best practice from flagship tackling poverty programmes such as Flying Start and Communities First into core service provision; and
- Encourage opportunities for greater collaboration between services and external partners in addressing poverty in Carmarthenshire.

It is proposed that the cross-party Panel will consist of six elected members (two from each group) together with the Executive Board Member with responsibility for Tackling Poverty. It is recommended that the membership would be consistent with the original members of the Focus Group. These are:

- 2 Independent representatives: Cllr. Hugh Richards & Cllr. Wyn Evans
- 2 Labour representatives: Cllr. Deryk Cundy & Cllr. Jan Williams
- 2 Plaid Cymru representatives: Cllr. J Eirwyn Williams & Cllr. Alun Lenny

Officer representatives from key tackling poverty initiatives will also contribute to the Panel as appropriate.

The Executive Board Member with responsibility for Tackling Poverty will chair the Panel and will elect a Vice-Chair from amidst the members. The Corporate Policy team will provide secretariat support to the panel.
