PUPIL REFERRAL UNIT (PRU) MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

BRIEF SUMMARY OF PURPOSE OF REPORT

A Pupil Referral Unit (PRU) is a type of school established by a Local Authority which has a duty to provide suitable education for children and young people who, by reason of illness, exclusion or otherwise, may not receive such education in a mainstream school.

There are a wide variety of PRUs across Wales; in Carmarthenshire, all our PRUs support learners with social, emotional and behavioural difficulties. They are diverse in terms of the number and type of pupils catered for, the typical length of stay, arrangements for admission and transfer to other education, the nature of the curriculum and length of the school day.

The different models of PRU provision are developed to meet local circumstances and are in line with local policies.

From September 2022, there will be four PRUs in Carmarthenshire – Canolfan Bro Tywi, Canolfan y Gors, Carmarthenshire Secondary Teaching and Learning Centre (CSTLC), Burry Port and Carmarthenshire Secondary Teaching and Learning Centre (CSTLC), Carmarthen.

A Management Committee, similar to a Governing Body for schools, oversees all our PRUs, and there is one vacancy for a Local Authority Member to serve on this Committee.
