Purpose:

The Forward plan sets out how CCC is delivering its Environment Act Duty 2020-2023

To consider and comment on the following issues:

The progress the Council is making in delivering its January 2020 to December 2022 Environment Act Forward Plan and fulfilling its legal obligation with reference to the Act.

Reasons:

The Environment (Wales) Act 2016 requires that all public bodies in Wales, such as local authorities, publish and deliver an Environment Act Forward Plan. These plans set out how an organisation will deliver its Section 6 Biodiversity Duty which is placed on it by this Act. The plan covers a period of three years.

It is Council procedure that the progress in delivering its Forward Plan is reported to EPP Scrutiny Committee every year. The Covid pandemic and pressure of other work has interrupted this process.

It is also a statutory requirement that every three years Carmarthenshire County Council reports on the delivery of its Environment Act Forward Plan to Welsh Government. It will next report to Welsh Government in December 2022

The Council's first Environment Act Forward Plan was published in March 2017, and delivery of it was reported to Welsh Government in December 2019. The following report refers to the Council's second three-year plan which runs from Jan 2020 to Dec 2022. The actions it contains are monitored in June and December each year via the Council's Performance Improvement Management System.

1. BRIEF SUMMARY OF PURPOSE OF REPORT

The purpose of this report and the plan attached is to inform to Scrutiny Committee of the Council's Environment Act Forward Plan 2020-2023 and the progress the Council is making in delivering the Biodiversity Duty placed on it by the Environment (Wales) Act 2016.

This duty is as follows:

'Section 6. Biodiversity and resilience of ecosystems duty (1)A public authority must seek to maintain and enhance biodiversity in the exercise of functions in relation to Wales, and in so doing promote the resilience of ecosystems, so far as consistent with the proper exercise of those functions.'

The actions set out in the Forward Plan are linked to the Council's Well-being Objectives (WBO10) and target dates for delivery of each action and the posts responsible are identified. Actions have been set out so as to be easily added to the relevant departmental business plans 2021/2022.

The Plan covers the period January 2020 to December 2022.

2. Legal

The delivery of the Environment Act Forward Plan 2020 – 2023 is consistent with the Section 6 Biodiversity Duty placed on all public bodies in Wales under the Environment Act (Wales) 2016. Delivery of the actions set out in the Report evidences the Council's commitment to fulfilling this duty and its compliance with this Act. It is also consistent with its responsibilities under the Well-Being of Future Generations (Wales) Act 2015 and in particular the Resilient Wales goal.

3.Finance

While the action plan identifies actions that will result in costs, these costs will be met by the budgets linked to these projects e.g., in Section 5 of the report all the site management works proposed are covered by existing budgets and grant aid. In both Section 6 Caeau Mynydd Mawr project and Section 7 Delivering Biodiversity on Development sites, all the actions proposed will be delivered via S106 agreements funded by developers.

5. Risk Management Issues

Failure to publish and deliver it Environment Act Forward Plan 2020-2023 places a reputational risk on the Council. It also risks its compliance with its S6 Biodiversity Duty under the Environment (Wales) Act 2016 and fulfilling its legal duty.

6. Physical Assets

Delivery of the Environment Act Forward Plan will have an impact on how the Council manages some of the assets for which it is responsible e.g., Action 7.3 - the management of Mynydd Mawr Woodland Park will change as areas of scrub development is reverted to open mosaic habitats.
