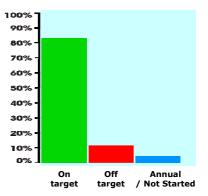

Comment	The Carmarthen and Ammanford Town Centre LDOs have been adopted following Council and Welsh Government Approval. An annual monitoring report will be produced in Feb 2023. An LDO for the Cross Hands East Strategic Employment Site has commenced with the preparation of an evidence pack and the development of pre-conditions. These will support the content of the LDO and its implementation. Discussion has been had with Cross Hands JV who are supportive of the LDO and work is progressing. This will be reported for consultation in due course. The Llanelli Town Centre LDO has ended following the expiration of its operational period. We will continue to monitor the potential and need for any future interventions within the Llanelli town centre.
