First can I say thank you for supporting me at the last election as your County Councillor. The year has flown by, and I cannot believe the huge challenges that we have endured since COVID. The fiscal challenges that were forecasted hit us hard as predicted, made worse with Ukraine and the fuel prices. The County Council team in Carmarthenshire embarked on the hardest budget in history, laid open to the public in consultation as to what priorities you thought should be protected, with over a £22 million cut in budget facing Carmarthenshire. Our policy in listening and engaging, empowering the people as never before has been so good, taking on board your views and concerns. We worked through each budget to bring about savings and to protect hard working people with family and mortgages and OAP's paying council tax.

It has been a hard challenging County year but worth every minute when I see progress and change for the better for us in Tyisha, Llanelli, and the County.
