There are no objections to this application, however the Police ask for strong and robust conditions and make the following representations:

- 1. A CCTV system shall be installed and maintained at the premises which gives coverage to all licensed areas, entry and exit points.
- 2. The system shall continually record whilst the premises are open and conducting licensable activities.
- 3. Footage from the CCTV system must be capable of being recorded onto an easily downloadable format.

- 4. Images recorded by the CCTV system shall be retained for a period of not less than 31 days and shall be provided to the Police or an authorised Officer of the Licensing Authority upon request.
- 5. All images recorded by the CCTV system shall denote an accurate date and time.
- 6. There must be at least one person at the premises at all times who is capable of operating the CCTV system.
- 7. The system must be registered with the Information Commissioner (Tel 0303 123 1113 or email registration@ico.org.uk)
- 8. There shall be "CCTV in Operation" signs prominently displayed at the premises.
- 9. A challenge 25 scheme to be adopted at the premises. There shall be notices displayed at prominent places throughout the premises including at all points of sale to inform customers and remind staff that the premises is operating a "Challenge 25" policy.
- 10. No person under the age of 18 shall be employed on the premises whether paid or unpaid for the purpose of serving alcohol.

The Police believe that the above conditions are necessary and appropriate to promote the Licensing Objectives.

I submit the above for your consideration and comment.
